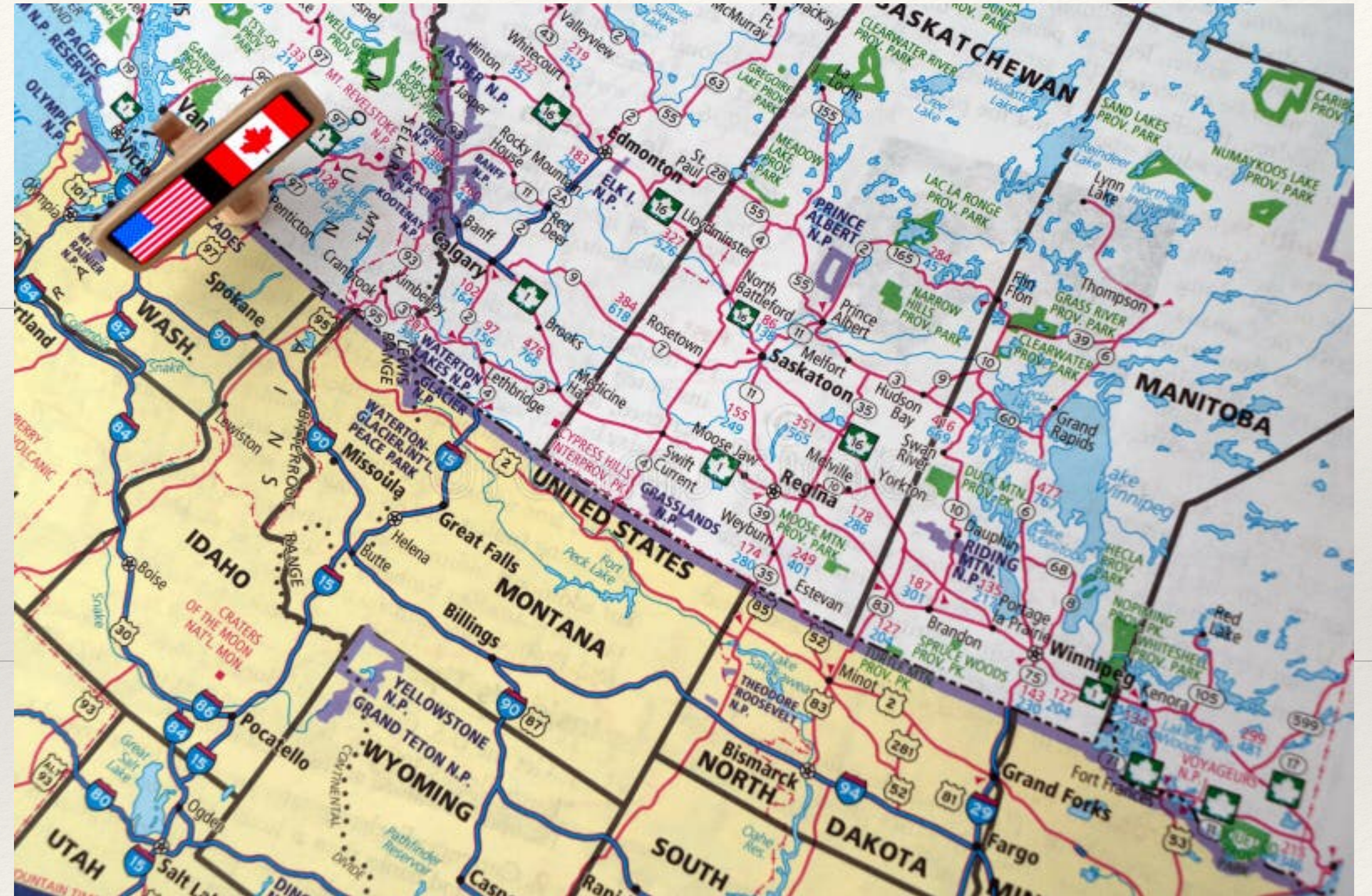


IN THE NEWS
