Storm Ciaran hit parts of the UK and Channel Islands

- Severe gales / gusts of wind / blasts of wind were recorded in Jersey with wind speeds of up to 104 mph (miles per hours) (= 167km/h)
- On the mainland, very high tides were seen in Devon and Cornwall.
- The storm lasted for three days before slackening, prompting (= resulting in) school closures and major travel disruptions.
- * Yet / However, the record-breaking gusts of 128 mph were seen at the coastal tip of the Pointe du Raz, in Brittany, France.
